Have you ever been shocked by an answered prayer?		
 Reflect	<input type="checkbox"/> Which one verse stands out to you? Why do you think it grabs your attention? <input type="checkbox"/> Which verse(s) will you need to think more about? Why?		
 Do	<input type="checkbox"/> Pray it forwards: pray for others in your small group. During the week, let individuals know you are praying for them. <input type="checkbox"/> Save the date. Get ready for 24 Hours of Prayer, 9:00 am Sat 30 <sup>th</sup> to 9:00 am Sun 31 <sup>st</sup> March.		
 Pray	Take time to pray for one another. Pray <a href="#">Acts 4:29-30</a> prayers. Pray in faith for more of <a href="#">Acts 4:31</a> .
